

Richardson and Comeau Claim the 2011 BMO Nesbitt Burns (Moncton) NB Ladies Four Ball

For immediate release (Bathurst, NB) – June 13th, 2010: Ladies from all over New Brunswick gathered in Bathurst today to kick off the 2009 BMO Nesbitt Burns (Moncton Branch) NB Ladies Four Ball Championship at Gowan Brae Golf Club. The event was preceded by the Ladies Invitational tournament hosted by the club making for a weekend long event.

BMO Nesbitt Burns (Moncton) is the title sponsor for the NB Ladies Fourball Championship. The tournament is a two-person best ball competition with both gross and net categories. This year's event carried a field of 34 teams (68 players).

Leanne Richardson & Sandy Comeau of Country Meadows retained their title of NB Ladies Fourball Champions. Richardson & Comeau fired and even par 72 to win the event. They posted two birdies in their round to claim a 2-shot victory over Allison Chisholm & Cathy Burgess of Riverside who were +2 (74). Huguette Poirier & Lucille Savoie of Pine Needles finished 3 shots off the lead with a 75.

In the Net Division, Huguette Poirier & Lucille Savoie of Pine Needles led the way with a net 59. Second place was won by Andrea Boucher & Erin Musgrave of Moncton with a net 61.

The New Brunswick Golf Association, a not for profit organization founded in 1934, is the official governing body for amateur golf in New Brunswick. In January of 2006, the NBGA officially merged with the New Brunswick Ladies Golf Association (NBLGA), resulting in one united governing body for amateur golf in the province.
