

Leanne Richardson and Brittany MacKenzie of Moncton's Country Meadows Golf Club captured the third annual New Brunswick adult/junior golf championship at the Maplewood Golf and Country Club yesterday.

It was the third straight year the Richardson/MacKenzie duo has claimed the female division title.

Richardson and MacKenzie won the crown in a two-hole playoff over Chris Spidell of Moncton and Alexandra LeBlanc of Country Meadows.

The two teams advanced to the playoffs after finishing the 18-hole event with 7-over par 79s.

Richardson was a member of the 2009 New Brunswick women's amateur team that competed at the Royale Canadian women's amateur championship at Royal Oaks Estates and Golf Club in Moncton a few weeks ago while MacKenzie was a member of the 2009 N.B. junior team and competed at both the Royale Canadian junior championships in Hampton and the Royale Canadian women's amateur at Royal Oaks.

The winners of the net division were Susan Sullivan and Claire Konning of Country Meadows with a net 64.

On the men's side, the father and son duo of Max and Myles Milligan of Riverside fired a 3-under 69 to take the title.

The Milligans won by four shots over Kraig Haddad and John Lawson (pro) of Country Meadows, the 2007 and 2008 champions, and Mike and Josh Barry of Nackawic.

The Barry team did take the net division with a net score of 57.
